Upper Makefield Township Board of Supervisors June 15, 2011 Meeting Minutes

The June 15, 2011 public meeting of the Upper Makefield Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chair Bud Baldwin at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were the following members of the Board of Supervisors: Chair Bud Baldwin, Vice Chair Tom Cino, Treasurer Mary Ryan and Member Dan Rattigan. Member Dave Kulig was absent. Also in attendance were Township Manager Stephanie Teoli and Township Solicitor John Rice, Esq.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND MOMENT OF SILENCE:

Mr. Baldwin led in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance which was followed by a moment of silence.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Mr. Baldwin announced that an Executive Session was held prior to tonight's meeting to discuss personnel matters.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Larry Breeden, 3 Bankers Drive, announced that three Upper Makefield residents were chosen to represent the United States in the World Championship Youth Dragon Boat Competition. He encouraged residents to support fundraising efforts for the team.

SPECIAL ITEMS

Resolution No. 2011-06-15-01 – Designating July as Park and Recreation Month

Mr. Baldwin introduced Resolution No. 2011-06-15-01 which designates July as Park and Recreation Month in Upper Makefield Township. NEW BUSINESS:

Friends of Washington Crossing Board Appointment

A motion was made by Ms. Ryan and was seconded by Mr. Cino to appoint Andrew Smith to the Friends of Washington Crossing Board for a four-year term which expires June 30, 2015. Motion carried on a 3-1 vote with Mr. Rattigan voting NO.

Privatization of Public Works Discussion

Ms. Teoli provided a presentation outlining the background and cost comparisons of outsourcing the public works department compared to maintaining the current small public works department with supplemental private contractors for specific projects.

Collective Bargaining Agreement - Highway Drivers and Helpers Local 107

Ms. Teoli provided a presentation on the proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement. After discussion by the board, a motion was made by Mr. Rattigan and was seconded by Ms. Ryan to authorize execution of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Upper Makefield Township and Highway and Helpers Local 107. Motion carried on a 3-1 vote with Mr. Cino voting NO. Mr. Cino noted his support of the public works staff and explained that his NO vote was based on his position that there should be cost sharing for healthcare and pension for new hires.

PUBLIC COMMENT AND MEDIA QUESTIONS:

Mike Murray, Washington Crossing expressed his appreciation to Mr. Cino for explaining his NO vote and encouraged other board members to do the same in the future. He then provided input on recent allegations that the township is not open and transparent in providing documents to residents. He commented that he was able to easily obtain information from the township regarding expenses from the Riparian Restoration Fund. He concluded by urging residents to become educated about all issues and noted that the existing board brings a great deal to the table.

Guy Polhemus, Washington Crossing Road, responded to Mr. Murray's comments, noting his 56-year residency in Upper Makefield, reiterating his claim that the township is not open and transparent. He asked for an, "open mic," format at the Public Comment portion of the agenda.

Mr. Rattigan responded that the Board of Supervisors has a long history of allowing residents to speak, uninterrupted, during the Public Comment portion of the agenda. He encouraged Mr. Polhemus to view meeting video on the web to see the many hours of Public Comment.

A motion was made by Mr. Rattigan and was seconded by Ms. Ryan to adjourn the meeting at 8:52 p.m. Motion carried on unanimous vote.
