## **SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE**

The proposed ordinance amends Ordinances 305 and 314, the Township floodplain ordinance, to allow fill in the floodplain in connection with the construction of permitted bridges, road crossings, and similar construction as approved by the Township Engineer. The use of fill shall be designed to insure that there is no change in the existing flood elevation at the upstream property line. The placement of fill shall be limited in dimension, shall consist of soil and small rock materials only, shall be compacted, and shall be no steeper than 1 vertical to 2 horizontal feet, nor shall fill adversely affect adjacent properties. All other provisions of Ordinances 305 and 314 will remain in full force and effect.
