After a sellout introduction this spring, free trees for residents may again be ordered for **October 28**, **2017 pickup** at the Upper Makefield Township Municipal Complex on Eagle Road.

Place your <u>online order now</u>. Orders are due October 27, 2017, but are reserved on a first-come basis. The spring program sold out within hours, so don't delay!

Residents may select from native species of Northern Red Oak, Eastern Redbud, Flowering Dogwood and River Birch trees. One hundred trees are available. Trees are 2-5 feet tall, and delivered in 5-gallon pots. If you participated in the spring program, please do not register again. Participation is limited to once per year.



Free trees are 2-5 feet tall in 5-gallon pots.

Working with the Arbor Day Foundation, participating residents will log onto an interactive website featuring aerial maps of their properties to determine the best tree placement for energy savings. The trees are a gift provided to you and our community by our UMTree Grant program.

If you now serve or have served in the military and were honorably discharged, did you know you are eligible for discounts at over 100 stores and restaurants in Bucks County? It is easy to qualify. Just bring your original DD-214 discharge form to the Recorder of Deeds Office in Doylestown. The office staff will record your Proof of Service and immediately issue a photo ID. In less than ten minutes, you can be out of the door with a color ID in hand!

Discount offers are updated quarterly, so you'll receive by mail each quarter a booklet describing local merchants. Discounts range from 5 to 20 percent. Details.

How Do I Report a Stray Animal or Injured Deer?

Call the Police Department. Tell us where the animal is located and what you know about its condition. Different locations require either PennDOT, Township, or Game Commission notifications. Phone: 215-968-3020.

How Do I Report a Problem with Trees?

The Township Public Works Department will field questions about problems with trees and direct you to the responsible party. Call them Monday-Friday from 7 a.m.-3 p.m. at 215-968-3314.

How Do I Request an Open Burning Permit?

Permits from our Fire Marshal are required for Open Burning. Please visit the

Township Building to submit a request to conduct Open Burning.

Note: For leaf disposal, contact your private hauler for directions on how to bag leaves for curbside pickup. Many have instructions online.
