November 13, a thank you was received from the Guardians of the National Cemetery on Sgt. Rauch and Officer Vitello's handling of the traffic detail for the Veterans Day ceremony. A copy is provided at the end of this report.

December 9, the rehearsal for the 66th annual reenactment of the "Crossing of the Delaware" took place. DCNR reported more than 4,000 attended. No criminal, traffic or medical calls were associated with this event.

TRAINING

Training for the upcoming months will include Mandatory In-Service, Supervisory Training for all Sergeants, Standard Field Sobriety Testing, Fire/Arson and Fatality Investigation, crime scene processing, Criminal Interdiction on Vehicle Stops, DNA processing, Firearms Recertification, Basic accident investigation for the new Officers and child/spousal/elder abuse training.

MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT

December 5, the task force met on RT332 and Campus Drive in Newtown Township. 17 vehicles were stopped and inspected yielding 4 citations, 4 warnings and one out of service.

December 10, Officers Crawford and Raza performed an inspection detail on Taylorsville Road at Heritage Hills Drive. Five commercial vehicles stopped and inspected, yielding three federal equipment violations and one out of service.
