HOLIDAY ELECTRICAL FIRE SAFETY & AWARENESS

According to the National Fire Protection Association 860 home fires are caused by electrical decorations each year. An additional 210 home fires are caused by Christmas trees each year. Follow these steps to insure you decorate your home safely during the winter holidays.

- Inspect electrical decorations for damage before use
- Never connect more than three strings of incandescent light
- Do not overload circuits as they can overheat and start a fire fuses that frequently blow and circuits that trip can indicate too many items are connected to the circuit
- Keep your Christmas tree fresh by watering daily
- Use battery operated candles
- Keep combustibles at least three feet from heat sources
- Protect electrical cords from damage do not run under carpets, through doorways or where they can be damaged by furniture
- Check illuminated decorations for a UL safety check label
- Stay in the kitchen when something is cooking
- Turn off, unplug all decorations when going to sleep or leaving the home
- Never remove the third prong on a plug
- Be sure to choose the right light strings and decorations as they are rated for indoor or outdoor use
- Keep outdoor connections above ground and out of puddles, don't run them across driveways or walkways
- Ensure that your **SMOKE ALARMS ARE WORKING!** Sit as a family and discuss what to do and where to go if smoke alarms activate!
