TRAINING

Training for this year included Mandatory In-Service, Crisis Intervention Team (CIT), Supervisory Training for all Sergeants, Officer Safety and Crimes Against Children. While the COVID-19 virus has cancelled a number of the above noted trainings, Officers have completed on-line mandatory in-service training along with in house firearms and taser recertifications.

Normal Business

During the fourth month of COVID-19, some of the contact restrictions have relaxed which has allowed the Officers to interact with the public. The response from the public is shown by:

June 15, a thank you email was received from the mother of 2-year-old who locked her out of the house and how Officers Kowalski and Edwards handled the situation.

June 24, a thank you was received from a local attorney on how Officer Walter treated him when he needed assistance along the side of the road.

June 29, an email of praise was received from a nanny on how Officer Walter spent time with some local children while he was on patrol.

July 2, a thank you note was received on Officer Carracci's handling of a medical emergency.

MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT

July 1 the team met in Newtown Township, inspecting 16 vehicles, discovering 13 safety violations which yielded 9 warnings, 4 citations and 2 out of service violations.

July 15, the team met on RT 32 at Lookout Park. During this detail, 18 commercial vehicles were inspected yielding 16 violations, 10 warnings, 6 citations and one out of service violation. Numerous residents stopped by the detail thanking the Officers for what they do every day.
