Shop with a Cop is a national program pairing police officers with children to afford them a better holiday season. This will be the third Shop with a Cop event that Upper Makefield Township, Newtown Borough and Newtown Township Police Departments will participate in. The program allows children to view police officers in a different atmosphere which helps promote positive relationships. The Shop with a Cop program is funded solely through the generosity of our local community’s residents and businesses. Volunteers from the community assist with gift wrapping, hosting, and registration.

Police Officers from Upper Makefield Township, Newtown Borough and Newtown Township volunteer their personal time to support the program. We anticipate over 60 children will participate in the program this year. The program’s participants are elementary and middle school students from the Council Rock School District. These children face life challenges such as a parent losing a job, homelessness, military deployment, economic shortcomings, and other hardships. Each child is allotted a monetary gift card to purchase gifts for themselves and their family members, allowing for a more enjoyable holiday.
