AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING CHAPTER 28B [STORMWATER: DELAWARE RIVER SOUTH WATERSHED] OF THE UPPER MAKEFIELD TOWNSHIP'S CODE OF ORDINANCE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP'S NPDES PERMIT FOR STORMWATER DISCHARGES FROM THE MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING CHAPTER 28A [NESHAMINY CREEK STORMWATER MANAGEMENT) OF UPPER MAKEFIELD TOWNSHIP'S CODE OF ORDINANCE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP'S NPDES PERMIT FOR STORMWATER DISCHARGES FROM THE MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4).

The proposed ordinances amend and restate the Upper Makefield Township Stormwater Management Ordinances (both the Neshaminy Creek Ordinance and the Delaware River South Stormwater Management Ordinance) to comply with the most current Pennsylvania regulations and NPDES requirements for storm water discharges. Specific changes allow the township to waive or modify regulations in accordance with the criteria set forth in the ordinance, requires revocation of a permit based on false or misleading information, amends certain definitions used in the ordinance, sets forth requirements for permitting and planning a stormwater management system to implement the goals of the for stormwater discharges, amends the regulations for volume controls, emphasizes the need for infiltration of stormwater, amends regulations to prevent streambank erosion, riparian corridor protection, revises the requirements for pipe materials and placement, required perpetual maintenance and inspections, amends the plan submission requirements, provides for the expiration of approval after five years, and amends and restates the prohibited discharges. The ordinance includes comprehensive changes to the stormwater management regulations, and all interested parties are urged to review the full text of the ordinance. The ordinance also provides an effective date of five days after enactment.
