NORMAL BUSINESS

On Saturday, October 29, the PD held a combined National Drug Take-Back and a "Pack the Patrol Car" event at police station. More than 187 pounds of old, expired drugs were removed from the public and will be destroyed. Many toys were donated to the patrol vehicle and will be distributed on December 10 when the "Shop with a Cop" takes place. On display was the Central Bucks Emergency Response Teams (CBERT) "Rescue Vehicle" and one of Bucks County M.ajor I.ncident R.esponse T.eam (MIRT) utility vehicles. Detective Jumper demonstrated the PD's Drone numerous times for the members of the public in attendance.
