## NORMAL BUSINESS

December 25, the 72<sup>nd</sup> reenactment of the “Crossing of the Delaware”, was held. Since the rehearsal upstate rains increased the level of the river permitting the event with more 8,000 seeing the speeches, parades, and cannon fire.

December 31, the annual calls for service were run for 2024. 8389 calls for service were handled a 5.89% increase over 2023. A detailed summary of all calls for service is attached at the end of this report. Detective Moore also has provided a summary of the year.

January 14, New Britain Township’s Chief sent a thank you note and a department challenge coin to each of the SRT and MIRT Officers (Russi/Carcaci/Moore) who assisted with the Polish Presidents visit in September. A copy is attached at the end of this report.

## MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT

December 10, the team met on Rt. 332 & Campus Drive in Newtown Township. During the detail, 29 commercial vehicle inspections were performed, yielding 6 traffic citations, 8 warnings, 6 out of service violations, 2 truck drivers placed out of service, 3 trucks placed out of service and 2 trucks towed from scene.

December 18, the team met on Taylorsville Road at Heritage Hills Drive. During the detail 13 trucks were inspected, yielding 6 equipment violations and 6 written warnings.

January 17, the team met on Rt. 332 and Campus Drive. During the detail 12 commercial vehicles were inspected resulting in NO driver/vehicle out of service violations found, no citation’s written and 4 warnings issued.
