Remediation**

Dear Director Patterson:

Please be advised that this firm serves as solicitor to Upper Makefield Township, which is in receipt of the Notice of Intent to Remediate issued by Groundwater & Environmental Services, Inc. on behalf of Energy Transfer dated March 4, 2025. Pursuant to Title 25, Chapter 250, Section 250.6(b)(2) of the Pennsylvania Code, Upper Makefield Township formally requests that it be involved in the development of the remediation and reuse plans for Mount Eyre Manor, as well as any other impacted areas within the Township's jurisdiction, related to Energy Transfer's ruptured pipeline.

Please note that this statement of intent to participate in the Act 2 remediation process is without prejudice to Upper Makefield Township's previous statement of intent to participate dated February 26, 2025. The former statement of intent to participate was issued in response to the Notice of Intent to Remediate issued on February 13, 2025.

The Township expects that Energy Transfer will create a public involvement plan and share it with the Township prior to its implementation. Further, the Township expects to have a seat at the table throughout the remediation process. For a more comprehensive statement of the Township's position on this matter, please refer to Resolution No. 2025-02-13-01, adopted by the Upper Makefield Township Board of Supervisors at a public meeting on February 13, 2025.
