May 2025 Recovery Well Installations

Energy Transfer, in coordination with a drilling contractor and an environmental management contractor, will be installing up to three (3) recovery wells in the roadway on Glenwood Drive in your neighborhood in May 2025. These wells are intended to locate and extract petroleum product from the groundwater table.

What to Expect:

Equipment: You will notice heavy machinery such as a sonic drill rig and air rotary drill rig.

Noise: Some noise is expected during work hours (9 AM – 5 PM), with maximum levels up to 99 decibels near equipment. Noise monitoring will be conducted to minimize disruption.

Water Use and Waste Management: The environmental management contractor will manage waste responsibly throughout the project.

Minimizing Impact: Throughout the process, air and noise monitoring will be conducted between the work area and nearby residences. Air samples will also be collected.


INSTALLATION PROCESS

PHASE 1 Arrival of equipment and mobilization.
Preparations will begin, including setting up safety fencing and sound barriers.

PHASE 2 After hand clearing for utilities, begin drilling the well with an air rotary rig to approximately 20 feet. Installation of steel casing in the wells.

PHASE 3 Completion of drilling to approximately 70 feet and development of the wells.





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
