DEPARTMENTAL EVENTS

June 9, the department covered Wrightstown Township and northern half of Newtown Township while that department attended the viewing and memorial service for Sgt. Frank Ambrose. This was an excellent example of our mutual aid with neighboring townships in their time of need.

TRAINING (Scheduled)

Most Officers will be taking mandatory in-service training via zoom, while some specialized training will be handled in the traditional way. As of this date, Officers have reservations for training in following subjects: Mandatory In-Service, Leadership Integrity for Police Leaders, Standard Report Writing, Standard Field Sobriety Testing, Command Level Training, Basic Accident Training, plus recertification in firearms/tasers and less lethal arrest techniques. The new federal guideline being implemented "Duty to Intervene" has been added to the training schedule.

MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT

May 19, the team met on Rt 413 & Foxhill Drive in Newtown Township. During the inspection detail, 18 commercial vehicles were inspected for safety violations yielding 7 citations, 13 warnings and one out of service violation requiring towing from scene.

June 2, the team met on RT 32 at lookout Park. During the inspection detail, 16 commercial vehicles were inspected resulting in 9 traffic citations and 9 written warnings being written with one out of service violation that was repaired at scene.
