TRAINING (Scheduled)

Officers have completed mandatory in-service training via zoom, while some specialized training will be handled in the traditional way. As of this date, Officers have reservations in 2022 for training in the following subjects: First Aid/CPR/AED recertifications, Mandatory In-Service, Leadership Integrity for Police Leaders, Standard Field Sobriety Testing, Command Level Training, Basic and Advanced Accident Investigations, plus recertification in firearms/tasers and less lethal arrest techniques.

MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT

February 9, the team met on the Newtown By-Pass at Campus drive in Newtown Township. 13 commercial vehicles were inspected, yielding 8 citations, 14 written warnings and 3 vehicles taken out of service for safety equipment violations. One was towed from scene for a leaking gas tank.

February 23, UMTPD and NTPD met on River Road at Lookout Park. During this inspection detail, 13 vehicles were stopped and inspected yielding 3 traffic citations, 10 written warning notices, one driver taken out of service for operating a vehicle while his commercial driver’s license was suspended.
