## **TRAINING (Scheduled)**

Officers have completed mandatory in-service training via zoom, while some specialized training will be handled in the traditional way. As of this date, Officers have reservations in 2022 for training in the following subjects: First Aid/CPR/AED recertifications, Mandatory In-Service, Leadership Integrity for Police Leaders, Standard Field Sobriety Testing, Command Level Training, Basic and Advanced Accident Investigations, plus recertification in firearms/tasers and less lethal arrest techniques.

## **MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT**

March 23, the team met in Newtown Borough at Washington and Elm Avenues. During this inspection detail, 16 vehicles were stopped and inspected yielding 12 traffic citations, 6 written warning notices and 3 commercial vehicles placed out of service for safety equipment violations.

April 5, Officer Crawford while on patrol in the area of RT 532 & Wrightstown Road, observed an unsecured load on trailer. Upon inspection of the vehicle numerous equipment/safety violations (7) were found and operator cited.

## **MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT**

April 8, DPW Road Master Scott called Officer Crawford when he found a truck/trailer stuck on Creamery Road. Upon investigation, Officer Crawford found numerous safety violations (no trailer brakes, unregistered vehicle, etc.). Operator was cited and vehicle towed from scene.
