Please see below for an overview of activities from the Public Works Department:

- Performed regular maintenance and inspections on Township building and facilities
- Repaired signs as needed and replaced numerous faded road signs across the Township
- Inspected, repaired and cleaned roadside drainage facilities and right-of ways
- Notified PECO of problems associated with their facilities
- Notified PennDOT of drainage issues and pot holes associated with state roads
- Notified Comcast and Verizon of downed communication wires, set barricades as needed
- Ordered parts and supplies as needed
- Responded to Pennsylvania One Call notifications
- Maintained service, repair and inspection of Township vehicles and equipment
- Responded to all complaints and concerns
- Public works firemen responded to 7 fire calls. Total time on calls = 16 1/2 hours
- Crew worked on inlet inspections and repaired inlets as needed
- Four (4) new man doors were installed in the Public Works upper shop garage
- Cleaned up outside Public Works storage areas
- Ordered and spread playground mulch for Lookout & Brownsburg Parks
- 3/7/22 – called in to clear down trees from roads & put out barricades due to high winds
- 3/8/22 – crew cleaned up down trees from high wind storm on 3/7/22
- Reviewed Stone & Asphalt bids from the Bucks County Consortium and made recommendations
- Checked on updates on 2 new dump trucks and backhoe that are on order
- Salted & plowed roads Saturday 3/12
- Called in to spot salt roads and plow snow drifts Saturday p.m. 3/12 & Sunday a.m. 3/13
- Emptied, cleaned up and made repairs to trucks after winter event
- Crew worked on cleaning up both parks to get them ready for April 1<sup>st</sup> opening
- Crew checked roads/drains after heavy rain 3/31, cleared and opened grates/drains as needed
