RE: MONTHLY POLICE REPORT

Normal Business

April 26 – 30 annual UMFD “CARNIVAL” was held. No major incidents were reported during this time.

April 30, National Drug Take Back event at the police station. This event generated 131+ pounds of expired drugs added to the county count from the residents of this township. The Chief of County Detectives reported to me on May 10 that this event yield more than 10,000 pounds of drugs to be incinerated.

May 2, a tragic event with the shooting and death of two boys in Timber Ridge took place. The Officers of this PD along with those from Lower Makefield, Newtown and Solebury Townships and the Bucks County District Attorneys office all came together in a very coordinated investigation. Within a few hours, a local resident via social media observed the suspect and she was taken into custody with no injuries to her or the Officers. The Central Bucks SRT’s Crime Scene Unit processed the scene throughout the day while the suspect was booked, arraigned and placed in Bucks County Prison to await trial. It must be noted that every Officer from this PD and those that responded to aid this township acted in the highest degree of professionalism to solve this crime.

TRAINING (Scheduled)

Officers have completed mandatory in-service training via zoom, while some specialized training will be handled in the traditional way. As of this date, Officers have reservations in 2022 for training in the following subjects: First Aid/CPR/AED recertifications, Mandatory In-Service, Leadership Integrity for Police Leaders, Standard Field Sobriety Testing, Command Level Training, Basic and Advanced Accident Investigations, plus recertification in firearms/tasers and less lethal arrest techniques.
