DARE

May 24, the annual DARE fun day was held for the sixth grade. Officer Crawford had the students wear the “Drunk Goggles” which mimic the effects of alcohol. Officer Raza demonstrated the MIRT (Major Incident Response Team) equipment. Officer Farra fingerprinted the children giving each one a copy of their prints for their parent’s records. Detective Jumper and this writer demonstrated the drone and had it fly a “DAREn” doll from the police station to SFES demonstrating the lifting capacity of the drone, along with group picture taking from an aerial perspective.

June 3, Sol Feinstone Elementary School (SFES) held the commencement for 127 sixth graders who completed the DARE training. Officer Crawford was greatly thanked by the class for his instruction this past year. This is the 25th year the PD has had the DARE program held at SFES. MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT

May 18, Officers met in Newtown Borough at Washington and North Elm Avenues. During the detail 13 commercial vehicles were inspected yielding 3 citations, 18 warnings and one vehicle placed out of service for safety equipment violations.

June 1, Officers from the task force met on the Newtown By Pass and Lindenhurst Road for an inspection detail. During the detail, 43 commercial vehicles were stopped and inspected, yielding 10 citations, 26 warnings, 3 vehicles placed out of service and one driver taken out of service.
