## **NORMAL BUSINESS**

July 4, 42<sup>nd</sup> annual REV-RUN @WCHP (Actual 40<sup>th</sup>) was held. Over 900 participants ran in the three events. No traffic, criminal or medical calls were related to this event.

## **MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT**

June 15, Officers from the task force met Lookout Park on RT32 for an inspection detail. During the detail, 10 commercial vehicles were stopped and inspected, yielding 6 citations, 14 warnings, and one vehicle was placed out of service for safety equipment violations.

June 29, Officers met on RT413 at Fox Hill Drive in Wrightstown Township for a safety inspection detail. During the detail, 10 commercial vehicles were stopped yielding 6 written citations, 7 warnings and one commercial vehicle was placed out of service.

## **TRAINING (Scheduled)**
